Dive into the hottest topics in Medicare reimbursement. A critical part of revenue integrity is staying up to date on Medicare regulatory changes. CMS publishes proposed and final rules on the Outpatient Prospective Payment System (OPPS), Inpatient Prospective Payment System (IPPS), and Medicare Physician Fee Schedule (MPFS) annually. The proposed rules provide regulatory updates CMS is considering enacting as well as an opportunity for the healthcare community to provide input through comments. The final rules detail the regulatory updates that CMS will implement.

In this session, we will help you stay up to date by providing you with details of the 2027 OPPS and MPFS proposed rules, as well as finalized updates in the 2027 IPPS final rule.
