Advocacy in Action

- In August, members of the NAHRI Advisory Board, including John D. Settlemyer, MBA, MHA, CPC, CHRI, and Michele Bear, DBA, MBA, CHRI, CRCR, CHC, CPC, in conjunction with members of American Society for Transplantation and Cellular Therapy (ASTCT), presented to the Advisory Panel on Hospital Outpatient Payment (HOP panel)
- NAHRI requested that the panel recommend CMS assign status indicator (SI) “S” to chimeric antigen receptor T-cell (CAR-T) Current Procedural Terminology (CPT®) codes 3X018, 3X019, and 3X020
 - These codes are currently assigned SI “B”
- NAHRI also recommended that CMS assign them to the most clinically appropriate Ambulatory Payment Classification (APC)

Advocacy in Action

- The panel accepted the recommendations of NAHRI and ASTCT without discussion
- What's next
 - The HOP panel will make its recommendations to CMS
 - CMS has historically accepted many of the panel's recommendations, or acknowledged and responded to them, in the Outpatient Prospective Payment System (OPPS) rulemaking process
- NAHRI also submitted a comment letter on the 2025 OPPS proposed rule, providing feedback on a range of issues including:
 - C-APC 8011
 - SI “K” drugs and C-APC packaging
 - Cell and gene therapies and C-APCs
