

Revenue Integrity Week Activity Sheet

When planning your Revenue Integrity Week celebration, consider the following recommendations from NAHRI:

- Use the NAHRI crossword puzzle, word search, scavenger hunt, and pop quiz from our <u>2021 Activity Guide</u> to run a friendly competition among your department and colleagues from other departments. Whoever finishes the quickest and gets the most correct gets a prize—or bragging rights! Answer keys are provided for the puzzle, word search, and quiz.
- Ask your team members to submit photos of themselves with a brief bio and a few facts. Create a PowerPoint or post and share it systemwide.
- Send virtual or physical thank-you cards to your team and other colleagues who work closely with you.
- Ask each team member to send in a few unknown facts. Compile them into a list and ask the team to match the facts with the person.
- Download NAHRI's 2021 State of the Revenue Integrity Industry Survey and distribute it to your team. Schedule a time to discuss what the results mean to your facility.
- Make sure your colleagues receive the accolades they deserve and nominate them as part of <u>NAHRI's Peer</u> <u>Recognition Program</u>. Certificates of recognition will be distributed to all who are nominated. All nominees and nominators will be entered into a drawing.

- Plan an event that will benefit your team, such as onsite or virtual education or a lunch and learn session, or something that will benefit your community, like a food drive with donations going to a local food pantry.
