

When planning your Revenue Integrity Week celebration, consider the following recommendations from NAHRI:

- Book a cooking class with your team.
- Host a bake sale benefitting a local charity.
- Gather your team for a cookie decorating activity.
- Hold a food drive and donate to a local food bank.
- Use the NAHRI crossword puzzle, word search, and other items from our <u>2025 Revenue Integrity Toolkit</u> to run a friendly competition among your department and colleagues from other departments. Whoever finishes the quickest and gets the most correct gets a prize—or bragging rights! Answer keys are provided.
- Ask your team members to submit photos of themselves with a brief bio and a few facts. Create a PowerPoint or post and share it systemwide.
- Send virtual or physical thank-you cards to your team and other colleagues who work closely with you.
